Dear Parent/Carer,

I hope this letter finds you and your families well. I just wanted to write to you before half term to give you an update about a couple of items.

This is a very exciting time for both schools as we set off together on this journey. Our Year 11 students are working extremely hard on their GCSE exams and I am delighted with the way in which they are approaching this challenging time for them.

We are seeing an increasing number of students arriving late to school which is impacting upon learning. Students who arrive at school after 9.30am without an acceptable reason will be marked with a 'U' code. This means 'Late after registration is closed' and counts as an unauthorised absence. This means that attendance will be affected and the involvement of Education Welfare or other agencies may be triggered.
