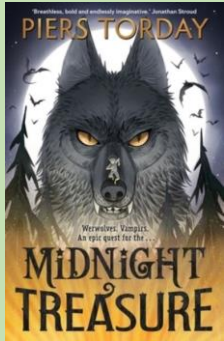

Book of the Month *NEW* to the ICC

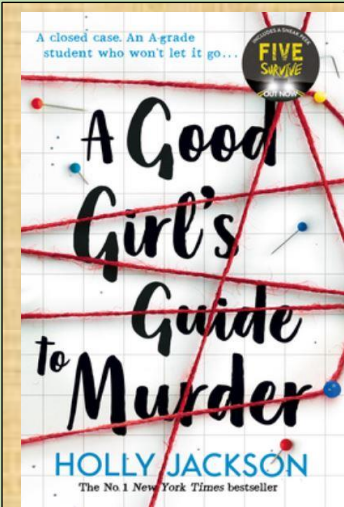

BOOK BUZZ – FREE BOOKS FOR YEAR 7

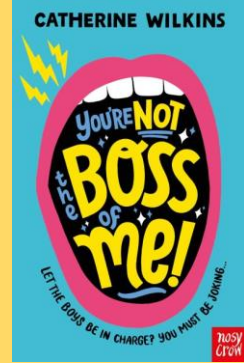
