Standards...

- Full uniform for school – including tie, blazer and appropriate school shoes
- Expected to bring bag with equipment which must include:
 - Pen
 - Pencil
 - Phone pouch*
 - PE Kit (*on PE days, to be advised*)
- Checked on arrival at the student entrance
- 30 minute after school detention for standards issue



Mobile Phones...

- From September 2026 we will be a Yondr school
- All students will be issued a Yondr pouch, which locks the phone inside using a magnet
- Each pouch will be named and numbered: the student takes responsibility for the pouch, but it remains the property of the school
- Pouches can be opened using a magnetic device at the end of the day
- Pouches will be part of the equipment/standards policy



Communication/My Child at School...

- School MIS is called 'BromCom'
- The parent app linked to this is 'MCAS'
- Each parent will need to download the app
- You will be sent login details
- Through this app you will be able to:
 - See parent letters and communications
 - Review and amend your/your child's details including consent for biometrics and photographs
 - View academic reports... and more



Communication / Class Charts

- ‘Class Charts’: rewards, sanctions & homework app
- Each parent will need to download the app
- You will be sent login details
- You can enable push notifications so updated in real time
- Through this app you will be able to:
 - View your child's positive and negative points, and the reasons for allocation
 - View your child's homework, and whether it has been submitted
