

Dear Parents and Carers,

Consultation on Proposed Changes to the School Day from September 2026

We are writing to inform you that we are opening a four-week consultation on a proposed change to the school day at both Litherland High School and Litherland Moss Primary School, with the changes taking effect from **September 2026**.

The governing bodies and school leaders have carefully considered a number of concerns that have been raised regarding the volume of traffic and congestion in and around the school car park at the beginning and end of the school day. The safety and wellbeing of all pupils, parents, carers, visitors and staff remain our highest priority. We believe that further staggering the start and finish times of the two schools will help to reduce congestion, improve site safety and create a calmer environment for everyone.

The proposed changes are as follows:

Litherland High School

- Proposed school day from September 2026: **8:30am – 3:00pm**

This change would allow the High School's 800+ students to arrive and be safely on site before the majority of Primary School pupils arrive. LHS pupils will still be able to arrive on site from 8:00am for breakfast club.

Litherland Moss Primary School

- Proposed school day from September 2026: **8:50am – 3:20pm**

Please note that the wraparound provision (breakfast club and hub club) would remain unchanged and continue to operate from **8:00am until 4:30pm**.

Before any decision is made, we would like to hear the views of parents and carers from both school communities. We encourage you to share any comments, questions or feedback through the consultation form linked below.

Consultation period: Friday 12th June 2026 to Friday 10th July 2026

All responses will be carefully considered before a final decision is taken. Following the consultation period, a summary of the feedback received will be reviewed by the governing bodies before a final decision is made regarding implementation from September 2026.
